











HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS: Financial Literacy Resources

	<h2>JA Personal Finance®</h2> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • JA Personal Finance Blended Model allows students to experience the interrelationship between today's financial decisions and future financial freedom. To achieve financial health and wellness, they learn about money-management strategies, including earning, employment and income, budgeting, savings, credit and debt, consumer protection, smart shopping, risk management, and investing. • Full program available which includes online and downloadable resources available through the JA Learning Platform. The details of their assigned life scenario include marital status, number of children, education background, employment, and income. Given their career and family situation, students use banking services; pay for housing, transportation, utilities, groceries, and health care; contribute to charities; and budget for education expenses. They work to create and balance a personal family budget. • On-line App.
